

Nomenclatural transfers for some northeastern USA desmids

The lectotype type species of the genus *Arthrodesmus* Ehrenberg ex Ralfs, *nom. illeg. non Arthrodesmus* Ehrenberg, *nom. illeg.* (cf. Compère 1976), *Arthrodesmus convergens* Ehrenberg ex Ralfs (Bicudo 1973, 1975), is currently referred to the genus *Staurodesmus* Teiling as *Staurodesmus convergens* (Ehrenberg ex Ralfs) S.Lillieroth; other species of *Arthrodesmus* Ehrenberg ex Ralfs have been referred to *Staurodesmus*, *Bourrellyodesmus* Compère and *Octacanthium* (Hansgirg) Compère.

However, several *Arthrodesmus* names from the older US literature have not been referred to appropriate genera. For an upcoming paper on Zyg nematophyceae from the New Jersey Pine Barrens, three such taxa require reassignment. *Arthrodesmus fragilis* Wolle 1880 is a monospinous form, which, according to Bicudo & Compère (1976), is referable to *Staurodesmus*, as is *Arthrodesmus ovalis* Wolle. *Arthrodesmus rauii* Wolle (Wolle 1883: 17) should be a *Xanthidium* according to Bicudo & Compère (1978) and Prescott, Bicudo & Vinyard (1982), but they did not effect a transfer, citing a poor description and illustration. However, based on the original drawing and their description, a move to *Xanthidium* is justified.

***Staurodesmus fragilis* (Wolle) Fairbanks, comb. nov.**

Basionym: *Arthrodesmus fragilis* Wolle, *Bulletin of the Torrey Botanical Club* 7(4): 47, 1880.

Type locality: Hammonton, New Jersey, August, 1879.

***Staurodesmus fragilis* var. *ovalis* (Wolle) Fairbanks, comb. nov.**

Basionym: *Arthrodesmus ovalis* Wolle *Bulletin of the Torrey Botanical Club* 10(2): 18, 1883

Synonym: *Arthrodesmus fragilis* var. *ovalis* (Wolle) C.E.M.Bicudo (in Prescott & al. 1982: 17)

Type locality: Mount Everett, Massachusetts.

***Xanthidium rauii* (Wolle) Fairbanks, comb. nov.**

Basionym: *Arthrodesmus rauii* Wolle, *Bulletin of the Torrey Botanical Club* 10(2): 17, pl. XXVII: figs 17, 17a.

Type locality: pond near Newfield, New Jersey; collected by E.A. Rau, August, 1882.
