

Nomenclatural notes on names of diatom taxa of J. Frenguelli. II. Resolving the nomenclatural history of *Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli (*Pinnulariaceae*, *Bacillariophyta*)

Navicula delicata was described from Quaternary sediments at Miramar, Buenos Aires Province, Argentina by Frenguelli (1926: 37, pl. II: figs 1, 2, as ‘*Navicula (Pinnularia) delicata*.’).

Subsequently, Frenguelli (1942: 131, pl. III: fig. 38) described *Pinnularia delicata* for a diatom collected in a small stream near Copahue volcano (Neuquén Province, Argentina). In a further publication, Frenguelli (1945: 180), mentioned “*Pinnularia delicata* Freng. - Lám. IX, fig. 19 - *Diat. Prebelgranense*, pág. 37, lám. 2, figs 1-2 (1926)”, seemingly referring to his *Navicula delicata* but without doing a formal transfer. In the same article Frenguelli added the following explanation to rectify the homonymy with *Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli 1942: “*Inadvertidamente, al describir las formas vivientes en un arroyito cerca del volcán Copahue, en la Cordillera del Neuquén, indiqué con el mismo nombre otra especie de Pinnularia* (Diat. Neuquén, pág. 131, lám. 3, fig. 38, 1942), *próxima a P. subcapitata* Greg. *Aprovecho esta oportunidad para proponer para esta segunda especie, cuya denominación necesariamente debe ser cambiada, el nuevo nombre de P. delicatula n. nom.*” [“Inadvertently, when describing the extant forms from a small stream near the Copahue volcano, in the Cordillera of Neuquén, I reported with the same name another species of *Pinnularia* (Diat. Neuquén, p. 131, lam. 3, fig. 38, 1942), close to *P. subcapitata* Greg. I take this opportunity to propose for this second species, whose denomination must necessarily be changed, the new name of *P. delicatula* n. nom.”].

Pinnularia delicatula Frenguelli (1945) is not referred to in most catalogues including that of VanLandingham (1978) and Sar & al. (2009). Although it was included in the catalogue of Luchini & Verona (1972) as a valid name, it was erroneously treated as a synonym of *Navicula delicata* Frenguelli 1926. When comparing the original descriptions and illustrations of *N. delicata* (Frenguelli 1926) and *P. delicata* (Frenguelli 1942), they are without doubt different taxa (see the original illustrations in Kociolek & al. 2021a, 2021b).

According to VanLandingham (1975: 2507; 1978: 3224), “*Pinnularia delicata* (Frenguelli 1926) F.W. Mills 1934, p. 1023” is the valid name for “*Navicula delicata* Frenguelli 1926, p. 37, 2/1-2 (*Pinnularia*)”, and “*Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli 1942, p. 131, 3/38” is an illegitimate name. Following his criteria, we considered the name *Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli, 1942 an illegitimate later homonym of “*Pinnularia delicata* (Frenguelli) F.W. Mills” and proposed the replacement name *Pinnularia copahuensis* Guerrero & Vouilloud for the former species (Vouilloud & Guerrero, 2021).

After the publication of the new name, we became aware of Frenguelli’s (1945) replacement name and this led us to re-examine the nomenclatural history of both taxa. The entry for this taxon in Mills (1934:1023) is as follows: “*Navicula delicata*, (Pinn.) Freng. Miramar, 1926, p. 37, 2/1, 2”, written in upper case letters, and thus considered a valid name, whereas there is no entry for *Pinnularia delicata*. Thus, Mills (1934) never made the transfer to *Pinnularia* as understood by VanLandingham (1975). Consequently, *Pinnularia delicata* is the valid name for the taxon validated in 1942 according to the principle of priority (Turland & al. 2018, Art. 11.4) and *Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli 1945 is a later homonym and thus illegitimate.

Additionally, we found that Mills (1934:1278) quoted as a valid name “*Pinnularia delegata*, Freng. Miramar, 1926, p. 37, 2/1, 2”, written in upper case letters, clearly referring to *Navicula delicata* Frenguelli 1926, but the specific epithet is clearly misspelled.

Considering this convoluted nomenclatural history, the following nomenclature change is required:

Pinnularia delicata Frenguelli, *Revista del Museo de La Plata (Nueva Serie)*, Sección Botánica 5(20), p. 131, pl. 3: fig. 38, 1942.

Homotypic synonyms: *Pinnularia delicatula* Frenguelli, *Revista del Museo de La Plata (Nueva Serie)*, Sección Paleontología 3: 180, 1945, nom. illeg. *Pinnularia copahuensis* Guerrero & Vouilloud, *Notulae Algarum* 220: 2, 2021, nom. illeg.

***Pinnularia maidanae* Guerrero & Vouilloud, nom. nov.**

Replaced name: *Pinnularia delicata* (Frenguelli) Frenguelli, *Revista del Museo de La Plata (Nueva Serie)*, Sección Paleontología 3: p. 180, 1945, nom. illeg. non *Pinnularia delicata* Frenguelli, *Revista del Museo de La Plata (Nueva Serie)*, Sección Botánica 5(20): 131, pl. 3: fig. 38, 1942.

Homotypic synonym: *Navicula delicata* Frenguelli, *Boletín de la Academia Nacional de Ciencias de Córdoba* 29: 37, pl. 2: figs. 1-2, 1926,
