

Nomenclatural notes on some *Micrasterias truncata* Brébisson ex Ralfs (*Desmidiaceae*, *Zygnematophyceae*) infraspecific taxa

Here we propose to update some infraspecific names of *Micrasterias truncata* Brébisson ex Ralfs that require revision in accordance with ICN Art. 11.4 (Turland & al. 2018).

Micrasterias truncata f. *montanica* Levanets & Janse van Vuuren, *nom. nov.*

Replaced name: *Micrasterias truncata* [var. *turgida*] f. *elevata* G.W.Prescott in Prescott & al. *A synopsis of North American desmids Part II. Desmidiaceae: Placodermae Section 2*: 200, pl. CI [101]: fig. 3, *nom. illeg.*, 1977. Priority for *Micrasterias truncata* f. *elevata* B.Eichler (1896: 130, pl. 4: fig. 39).
